The Third Conference in the Humanities
March 12, 2012
Theme: Language**

The conference is a one-day event, centered this year around the theme of language. There will be discipline-specific roundtable discussions where 4-5 students present their papers, with faculty members serving as moderators. Students will have 12 minutes to present their papers and 5 minutes to answer questions.

Prizes:

First prize is a cash prize award of 400 dollars. Every participating student will also receive a certificate as an undergraduate research scholar, and all papers included in the conference will be printed as part of the conference proceedings.

Eligibility:

- * The applicant needs to be an active UTSC student
- * The paper needs to address the theme of the conference.

Eligible formats for submissions are research-based papers, creative writing pieces, performance reviews, artistic performances, and other non-traditional investigations of language in its broader sense.

Possible topics are, but not limited to: language and literature, language and immigration, language and the media, absence of language, language and silence, language and memory, language and multiculturalism, language and education, language and creativity, language and the Arts, language and identity, language and the workplace, language and religion, language and literacy, language and body, language and gender, language and storytelling, and English as a second language.

Deadlines:

Questions about the conference and submissions of full papers must be sent via email (as doc or pdf) to Dr. Maria Assif (massif@utsc.utoronto.ca).

Deadline for submissions is: February 29th, 2012.

An undergraduate committee will select the final papers that will be part of the conference. Students with accepted submissions will be contacted by March 5th, 2012.
